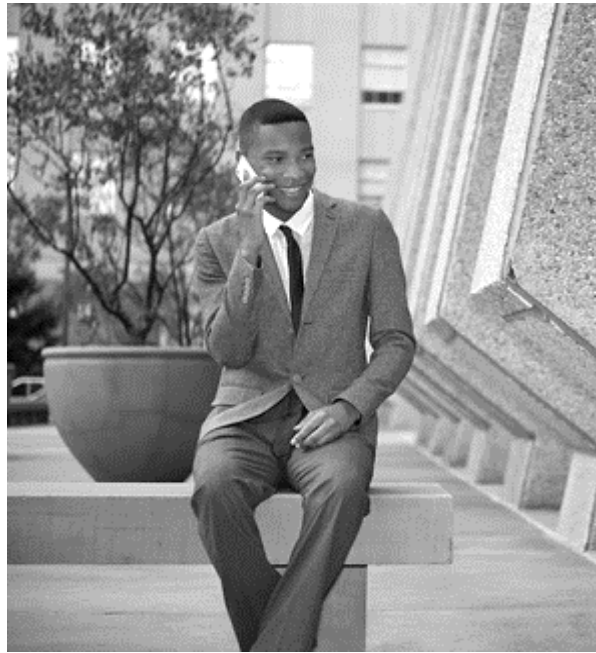
Is Christian Hip-Hop Music making a splash?
